Ezra 5, "Back in the Saddle Again" 5/21/23

Ezra 5:1-2

The Lord sends 2 prophets to encourage the exiles to resume work on the temple:

Haggai –gives 4 messages over 4 mos. to the exiles in 520 BC. (1:2-11. Exiles have made 3 F's)

- Forsaken the Lord by giving in to *your* own comfort & desires (*living in paneled houses*).
- <u>Feared the world, not the Lord...not learning from the Lord's discipline (\$, crop failure).</u>
- <u>F</u>orgotten that the Lord is with <u>you</u>.

<u>Zechariah</u> – preached <u>2 yrs</u>. Gave them hope: God keeps His word, so put His kingdom first! <u>Zech. 1:3</u>, "*Return to me says the LORD of hosts, & I will return to you.*"

- Zechariah: The Lord remembers. Berechiah: The Lord blesses. Iddo: At the appointed time.
- "The Lord remembers, the Lord blesses, at the appointed time." Your focus: on the Lord!

Ezra 5:11-14

The Elders answer 5 questions:

- 1) Who are we? "The servants of the God of heaven & earth" -
 - 2 interpretations of the title:
 - Jews are being *shrewd*. Darius is a follower of Ahura Mazda, "God of heaven."
 - Jews are being <u>bold</u>. "The God of Heaven <u>AND</u> earth." Challenge the Persians...
- 2) What are we doing? "Rebuilding the temple that was built many years ago, which a great king of Israel built & finished."
- 3) Why are we in this predicament? "Our fathers provoked the God of heaven to wrath."
- 4) How did it occur? "He gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar..."
- 5) Why are we rebuilding the temple? "A decree was issued by King Cyrus."
