John 4:27-42, "The Wisdom of Winning Souls"

Pr. 11:30, "The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and the one who wins souls is wise."

Outline:

Jn. 4:27-30, Christ uses the witness of those who are passionate for Him and willing to go.

Jn. 4:31-38, Christ encourages His followers to embrace a harvest mindset.

Jn. 4:39-42, Christ rewards those who actually go out to bring others to Him.

4:28, "So the women left her water jar..." – WHY?

- 1. She leaves her jar due to her excitement in telling others of the Messiah.
- 2. She leaves her jar so that Jesus could finally get a drink of water.
- 3. Symbolically, she won't need the jar anymore since she now has the waters of life.

4:38, "For here the saying holds true, "sow and another reaps.'"

- Sower: sows anticipating what is to come (God uses my witness to enact mercy or justice)
- Reaper: never forgets the harvest he is experiencing is due to another's sowing.
- 1 Cor. 3:5-8, "What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each. I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. He who plants and he who waters are one, and each will receive his wages according to his labor."

Questions on winning souls (being a witness):

- Am I as committed to the Lord's work as He is?
- Am I willing to forego a meal, discomfort, or reputation for me to follow the Lord's will?
- What are some of my self-made hindrances that keep me from carrying out the Lord's will?

Advice on winning souls (being a witness):

- 1. Pay NO attention to the 'success rate' (<u>not</u> how God judges).

 2 Cor. 2:15-16, [W]e are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing, to one an ODOR from death to death, to the other a FRAGRANCE from life to life..."
- 2. Pray as you obey. <u>Lk. 10:2</u>, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."
- 3. Get to work in the field the Lord has sovereignly put you. <u>1 Cor. 15:58</u>, "Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain."
